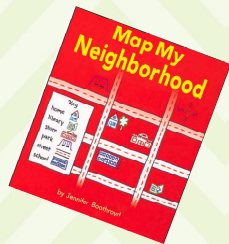
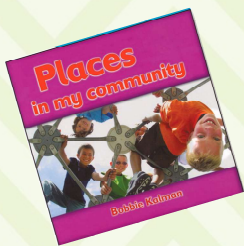


Whittier K5

With the books this week we will be working on identifying characteristics of informational texts. We will be working on the letter sound I (Iggy Inchworm). The focus letter will be, the letter P. Our reader this week will be **Let's Go See Farm Animals**. This week we will be working on the following words: **an, has, it, we, see** and **go**.



In math we will be making sense of a problem involving the quantity 5. Adapting strategies to solve a related problem involving quantities and numbers to 5. We will also be classifying, counting, and comparing to make sense of information.
