
Week of January 12th, 2026

We will be working on Identifying the topic and central idea of an informational text. We will be working on the letter sounds L (Lamar Lobster) and H (Hattie Horse). Our reader this week will be **Do you like January?** This week we will be working on the following words: **are, lot, not, was, you, do** and **like**.



In math we will be count up to 10 using one-to-one correspondence and number words in sequential order. We will also be using a 10-frame as a tool to count and represent counts to 10.
