Our reader this week will be **Winter is Here!** This week we will be working on the following words: **be, do, had, ten, will, my** and **get**.



In math we will be identifying whether the number of objects (to 10) in one group is greater than, less than, or equal to the number in another group. We also will be comparing two numbers from 1 to 10.
