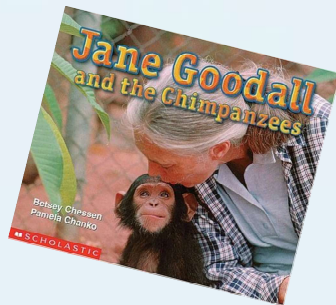


Whittier K5
